Costs	<ul> <li>Fees to be paid in full before the training <ul> <li>Tuition fees: \$1 438.42 (TO CONFIRM)</li> <li>School material expenses: \$132</li> </ul> </li> <li>Other costs to provide <ul> <li>\$150 for two black or navy pants and two light blue shirts purchased at the store of your choice</li> <li>\$100 approximately for the purchase of safety shoes in a store of your choice;</li> <li>\$72 for class 1 apprenticeship fees (SAAQ)</li> <li>About \$16 for Class 1 (SAAQ) license fees</li> <li>\$55 approximately to have a doctor complete the medical report required by the SAAQ (to obtain the apprentice class 1)</li> <li>Safety vest</li> <li>Safety glasses, mask and antiseptic gel (for example Purel)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>For the student who decides to do long distance during his internship</li> <li>Allow about \$150 per week for living expenses</li> </ul>

Proof of schooling	<ul> <li>Meet the requirements of the Quebec Ministry of Education</li> <li>Have completed equivalent studies outside Quebec and provide the original academic documents (diplomas and transcripts)</li> <li>OR</li> <li>Provide a comparative evaluation of studies done outside Quebec</li> </ul>

Other documents to provide	<ul> <li>Registration form completed on <u>www.admissionfp.com</u> (the completed form must be printed, dated and signed and provided with all required documents)</li> <li>Original of birth certificate</li> <li>Citizenship certificate or card or permanent residence card if you are born outside of Canada</li> <li>Academic record</li> <li>Evidence of success of the SAAQ's visual and medical tests (see below)</li> <li>Driver Record issued by the SAAQ</li> </ul>
