To study at the *Centre de formation du transport routier de Saint-Jérôme (CFTR)*, you will need to meet the specific requirements of the CFTR's targeted training program as outlined below.

Costs	 Fees to be paid in full before the training Tuition fees: \$1 438.42 (TO CONFIRM) School material expenses: \$132 Other costs to provide \$150 for two black or navy pants and two light blue shirts purchased at the store of your choice \$100 approximately for the purchase of safety shoes in a store of your choice; \$72 for class 1 apprenticeship fees (SAAQ) About \$16 for Class 1 (SAAQ) license fees \$55 approximately to have a doctor complete the medical report required by the SAAQ (to obtain the apprentice class 1) Safety vest Safety glasses, mask and antiseptic gel (for example Purel)
