

CANADIAN STUDENTS OUTSIDE QUEBEC

To study at the *Centre de formation du transport routier de Saint-Jérôme (CFTR)*, you will need to meet the specific requirements of the CFTR's targeted training program as outlined below.

<p>Costs</p>	<p>Fees to be paid in full before the training</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Tuition fees: \$1 438.42 (TO CONFIRM) ▪ School material expenses: \$132 <p>Other costs to provide</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ \$150 for two black or navy pants and two light blue shirts purchased at the store of your choice ▪ \$100 approximately for the purchase of safety shoes in a store of your choice; ▪ \$72 for class 1 apprenticeship fees (SAAQ) ▪ About \$16 for Class 1 (SAAQ) license fees ▪ \$55 approximately to have a doctor complete the medical report required by the SAAQ (to obtain the apprentice class 1) ▪ Safety vest ▪ Safety glasses, mask and antiseptic gel (for example Purel) <p>For the student who decides to do long distance during his internship</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Allow about \$150 per week for living expenses

<p>Proof of schooling</p>	<p>Meet the requirements of the Quebec Ministry of Education</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Have completed equivalent studies outside Quebec and provide the original academic documents (diplomas and transcripts) <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Provide a comparative evaluation of studies done outside Quebec

Other documents to provide	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Registration form completed on www.admissionfp.com (the completed form must be printed, dated and signed and provided with all required documents) ▪ Original of birth certificate ▪ Citizenship certificate or card or permanent residence card if you are born outside of Canada ▪ Academic record ▪ Evidence of success of the SAAQ's visual and medical tests (see below) ▪ Driver Record issued by the SAAQ
