To study at the *Centre de formation du transport routier de Saint-Jérôme (CFTR)*, you will need to meet the specific requirements of the CFTR's targeted training program as outlined below.

<p>Costs</p>	<p>Fees to be paid in full before the training</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Tuition fees: \$24 281 (TO CONFIRM) ▪ School material expenses: \$132 <p>Other costs to provide</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ \$150 for two black or navy pants and two light blue shirts purchased at the store of your choice; ▪ \$100 approximately for the purchase of safety shoes in a store of your choice; ▪ \$72 for class 1 apprenticeship fees (SAAQ); ▪ About \$16 for Class 1 (SAAQ) license fees; ▪ \$55 approximately to have a doctor complete the medical report required by the SAAQ (to obtain the apprentice class 1). <p>For the student who decides to do long distance during his internship</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Allow about \$150 per week for living expenses.

<p>Proof of schooling</p>	<p>Meet the requirements of the Quebec Ministry of Education</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Have completed equivalent studies outside Canada and provide the original academic documents (diplomas and transcripts) <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Provide a comparative evaluation of studies done outside Quebec

<p>Other documents to provide</p>	<p>1st step - Send the following documents by email for a pre-analysis:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Original of birth certificate ▪ Valid passeport ▪ Academic record (diplomas and transcript) <p>2nd step - Once you have confirmation, you can complete the hand copy application form for foreign students in the application section on the website www.admissionfp.com (the completed form must be dated and signed and sent by email)</p> <p>3rd step - Upon arrival in Quebec you must provide us with the originals of all your documents as well as the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Certificate of acceptance of Quebec for studies (CAQ) ▪ Study Permit from Canada ▪ Work Permit for Internship (Canada) ▪ Copie of you Quebec driver's license ▪ Evidence of success of the SAAQ's visual and medical tests (see below) ▪ Record of conduct issued by the SAAQ
<p>Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ If applicable, have your driver's license (class 5) recognized by the SAAQ: https://saaq.gouv.qc.ca/en/drivers-licences/foreign-drivers-licence/ ▪ Meet the SAAQ requirements for obtaining a class 1 license (heavy vehicles): https://saaq.gouv.qc.ca/en/drivers-licences/obtaining-licence/heavy-vehicles/
