

STUDENTS WITH RECOGNIZED REFUGEE STATUS

To study at the *Centre de formation du transport routier de Saint-Jérôme (CFTR)*, you will need to meet the specific requirements of the CFTR's targeted training program as outlined below.

Tuition fees	<p>Fees to be paid in full before the training:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ School equipment fees: \$132 <p>Other costs to provide:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ \$150 for two black or navy pants and two light blue shirts purchased at the store of your choice ▪ \$100 approximately for the purchase of safety shoes in a store of your choice; ▪ \$72 for class 1 apprenticeship fees (SAAQ) ▪ About \$16 for Class 1 (SAAQ) license fees ▪ \$55 approximately to have a doctor complete the medical report required by the SAAQ (to obtain the apprentice class 1) <p>For the student who decides to do long distance during his internship:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Allow about \$150 per week for living expenses

Proof of studies	<p>Meet the academic requirements by providing documents recognized by the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur du Québec</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Have completed equivalent studies outside Canada and provide the original academic documents (diplomas and transcripts) <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Comparative evaluation of studies done outside Quebec

<p>Documents to provide</p>	<p>1st step: Provide the CFTR with the documents below</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Completed registration form on www.admissionfp.com (copy to print and to be provided with the documents) ▪ Original birth certificate ▪ Quebec Selection Certificate (CSQ) - Field # 9 must indicate the code R8 or RA ▪ School records (diplomas and transcript) ▪ Record of conduct issued by the SAAQ ▪ Quebec driver's license ▪ Evidence of success of the visual and medical tests of the SAAQ (see below) ▪ Proof of residence <p>2nd step: An admission letter will be given to you to help you get the documents below that need to be provided before you start the program</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Canada Study Permit ▪ Work permit for the internship
<p>Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ)</p>	<p>Comply with the requirements of the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ) to obtain a Class 1 driving license</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ If applicable, have the Quebec SAAQ (class 5) driving license validated: https://saaq.gouv.qc.ca/en/drivers-licences/foreign-drivers-licence/ SAAQ Montréal: 855, boul. Henri-Bourassa Ouest, Montréal, H3L 1P3 / 514 873-7620 ▪ Hold a permit equivalent to Quebec Class 5 for at least 36 months ▪ Have a file that must not contain more than three demerit points ▪ Have a driver's license that must not be suspended or revoked in the last two years as a result of an accumulation of demerit points or a Criminal Code offense committed while driving a road vehicle ▪ Pass a visual test and have a medical declaration completed
<p>Education language</p>	<p>Demonstrate an understanding of the language of instruction.</p>
