

## CANADIAN STUDENTS OUTSIDE QUEBEC

To study at the *Centre de formation du transport routier de Saint-Jérôme (CFTR)*, you will need to meet the specific requirements of the CFTR's targeted training program as outlined below.

<p><b>Costs</b></p>	<p><b>Fees to be paid in full before the training</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Tuition fees: <b>\$1 450 (exact amount to be confirmed)</b></li> <li>▪ Material costs: <b>\$124.25</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Other costs to provide</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ \$150 for two black or navy pants and two light blue shirts purchased at the store of your choice</li> <li>▪ \$100 approximately for the purchase of safety shoes in a store of your choice</li> <li>▪ \$85 for class 1 apprenticeship fees (SAAQ)</li> <li>▪ \$16 for Class 1 (SAAQ) license fees</li> <li>▪ \$55 approximately to have a doctor complete the medical report required by the SAAQ to obtain the apprentice class 1</li> </ul> <p><b>For the student who decides to do long distance during his internship</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Allow about \$150 per week for living expenses</li> </ul>

<b>Proof of schooling</b>	<p><b>Meet the requirements of the Quebec Ministry of Education</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Have completed equivalent studies outside Quebec and provide the original academic documents (diplomas and transcripts).</li> </ul> <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Provide a comparative evaluation of studies done outside Quebec.</li> </ul>
<b>Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Have your Quebec driver's license (class 5) recognized by the SAAQ: <a href="https://saaq.gouv.qc.ca/en/drivers-licences/canadian-foreign-drivers-licence">https://saaq.gouv.qc.ca/en/drivers-licences/canadian-foreign-drivers-licence</a>.</li> <li>▪ Meet the SAAQ requirements for obtaining a class 1 license (heavy vehicles): <a href="https://saaq.gouv.qc.ca/en/drivers-licences/obtaining-licence/heavy-vehicle/drivers-licence-class-1">https://saaq.gouv.qc.ca/en/drivers-licences/obtaining-licence/heavy-vehicle/drivers-licence-class-1</a>.</li> </ul>

<b>ORIGINAL documents to provide</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Registration form completed on <a href="http://admissionfp.com">admissionfp.com</a>, printed, dated and signed</li> <li>▪ Birth certificate</li> <li>▪ Proof of schooling</li> <li>▪ Driver Record issued by the SAAQ</li> <li>▪ Quebec driver's license</li> <li>▪ Evidence of success of the SAAQ's visual and medical tests</li> <li>▪ Proof of residence in Quebec</li> <li>▪ 2 authorization forms</li> </ul>
